When Sir John Templeton was a young man wondering what to do with his life, he thought of becoming a Christian minister. But he saw others had more talent for such a calling and decided to become an investor who would raise money for God's work. He was unbelievably gifted at investing. He started the Templeton Mutual Fund Company. His wealth increased by leaps and bounds. He became a trustee of Princeton Seminary at which time the seminary's endowment was \$3 million. Today, primarily through Sir John's advice and help, the endowment amount is over \$450 million. Beyond that, it is Sir John who sponsors the Templeton Prize in Religion.

It is believed that new insights and discoveries in matters of the spirit will come forth from Sir John's encouragement of those who are on the cutting edge of religion. I believe this earth is created by Somebody far wiser than I and that there's probably some purpose in the things that happened to me...I doubt if I'll ever understand why it is, but I don't have any trouble believing that the One who created the earth is doing it in the right way."

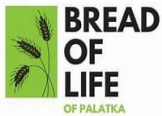
